*Radix Polygoni Multiflori

is the dried tuber of Polygonum multiflorum Thunb. in the family Polygonaceae

Radix Polygoni Multiflori[#] (Polygoni Multiflori Radix Praeparata)

is the dried and processed tuber of *Polygonum multiflorum* Thunb. in the family Polygonaceae

Overview

The Chinese Materia Medica (CMM) Radix Polygoni Multiflori is listed in both the Schedule 2 of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance and the Chinese Pharmacopoeia (2020). The Chinese Pharmacopoeia endorses two types of CMM, namely Radix Polygoni Multiflori and Polygoni Multiflori Radix Praeparata. The decoction pieces of Radix Polygoni Multiflori are produced from cleansing, and cutting the Radix Polygoni Multiflori into thick slices or pieces, followed by drying whilst the decoction pieces of Polygoni Multiflori Radix Praeparata are produced by stewing with black bean juice, steaming or mixed with black bean juice followed by steaming and it is listed as an individual CMM. As these two CMM are produced from the same source, the appearance of the raw and processed products are very similar. According to the Chinese Pharamcopoeia, Polygoni Multiflori Radix Praeparata can tonify the liver and kidney, replenish essence and blood, blacken the beard and hair, strengthen the sinew and bone, and resolve turbidity and reduce fat; while Radix Polygoni Multiflori can detoxify, disperse abscesses, interrupt malaria and moisten the intestines and relax the bowels. As the efficacy of these two CMM varies, they should be used accordingly.



Key identification features

Macroscopic features of Radix Polygoni Multiflori decoction pieces





Outer surface is brown, reddishbrown or greyish-brown, shriveled, uneven and has shallow grooves

With protruded long horizontal lenticels


With rootlet scars

Cut surface is light yellowish-brown, light brown or light reddish-brown and starchy

Bark has sub-rounded and annularly arranged anomalous vascular bundles which form brocaded patterns in transverse section. Centre has relatively large wood

Micro-morphological feature


A: With observable sub-rounded, linear or dotted brown substance



Macroscopic features of Radix Polygoni Multiflori (Polygoni Multiflori Radix Praeparata) decoction pieces



Irregularly shriveled slices



Surface is blackish-brown or brown and uneven

Cut surface is horny, brown, deep brown or blackish-brown. Some have deep brown vein striations or sub-rounded annularly arranged anomalous vascular bundles which form brocaded patterns





Additional information

Photo of crude Radix Polygoni Multiflori



In masses or irregular fusiform, 6-15 cm long, 4-12 cm in diameter

Surface is reddish-brown, shriveled, uneven and has shallow grooves, long horizontal lenticel-like protuberances and rootlet scars

Fracture is light yellowish-brown or light reddish-brown and starchy. Bark has 4-11 sub-rounded and annularly arranged anomalous vascular bundles which form brocaded patterns. Centre has relatively large wood which some appear wood core-like

- Heavy, hard and not easily broken
- Slight odour, slightly bitter, sweet and astringent taste
